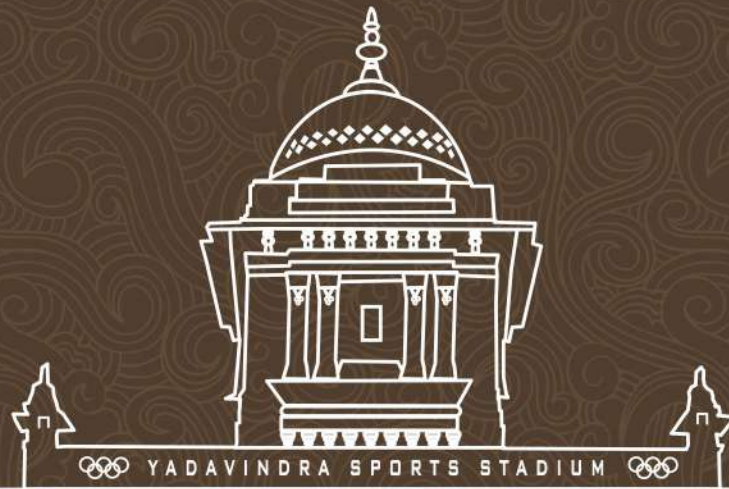

# THE FETE

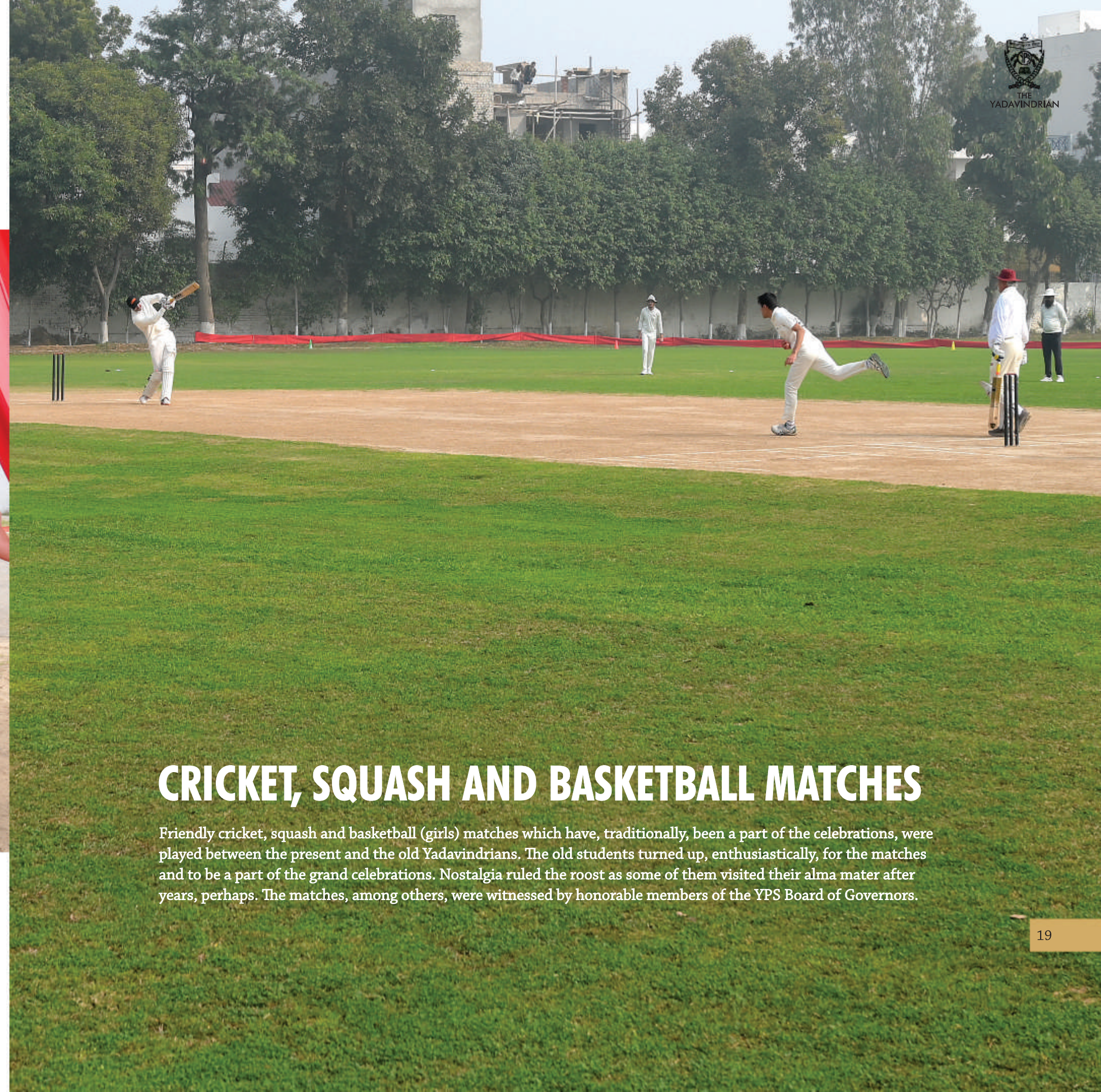

# 76<sup>th</sup> SPORTS DAY CELEBRATIONS

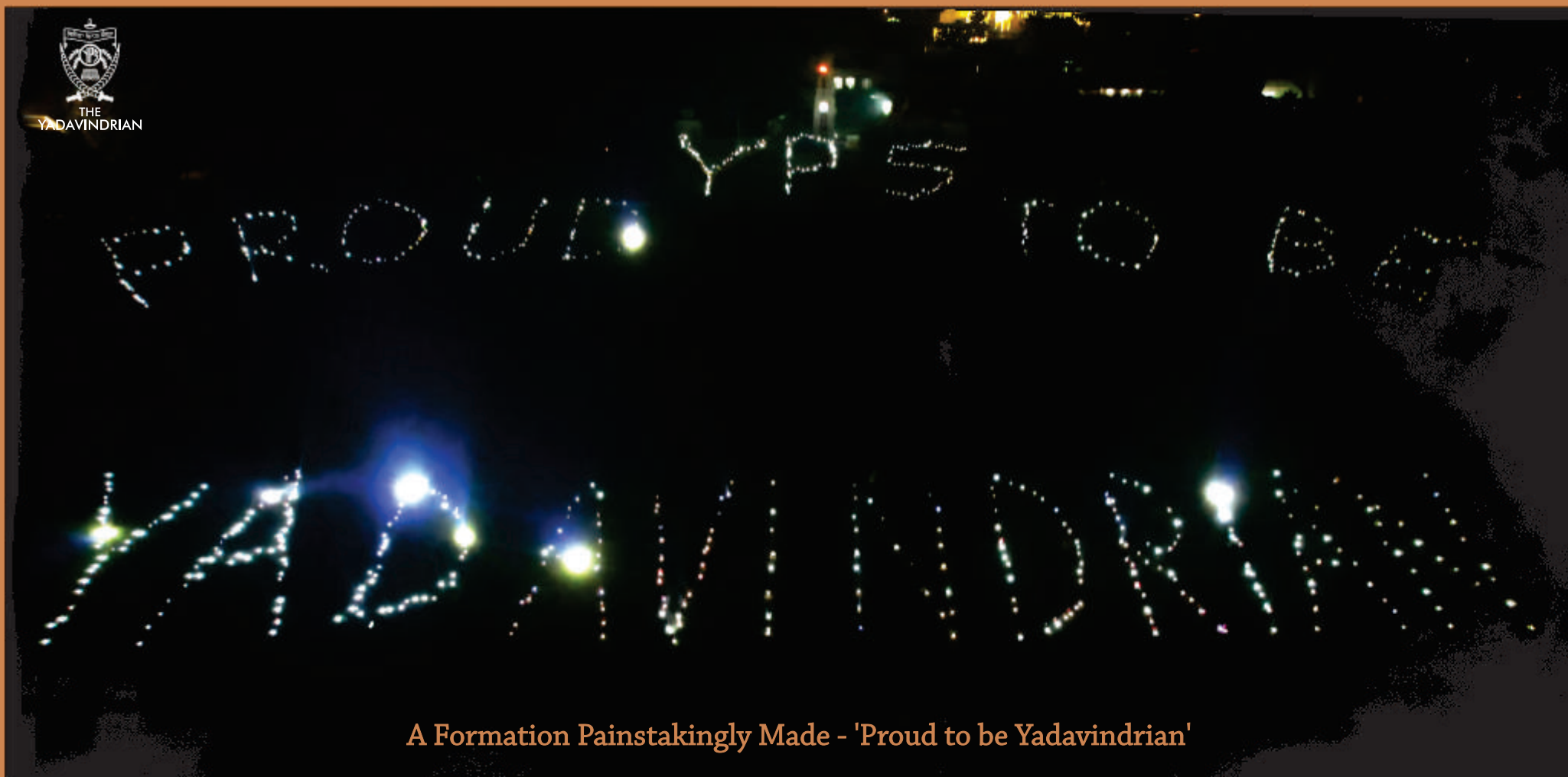

## ISC AND ICSE EXAMINATION (2024-25) RESULTS - SCHOOL PRODUCES NATIONAL AND STATE TOPPERS

The school received with joy, pride and exultation, the much - awaited results of the ISC and ICSE : 2025 examinations on April 30. The students performed exceptionally well and did the school proud in both the examinations. Both the ISC and ICSE results were 100 percent pass results.

### ISC RESULTS -

In class XII, 77 students appeared out of which 36 students scored over 90 percent and 31 students scored over 80 percent marks

The first three positions are-

1st - Mallik Arjun Ahluwalia - 99.75 percent

2nd - Divroop Kaur Sandhu - 98.75 percent

3rd - Ira Mittal - 98.25 percent

Suhani Singla topped the Commerce stream with 96.25 percent



### ICSE RESULTS -

The class X ICSE results were equally impressive. Out of 116 students, 39 scored over 90 percent and 45 scored over 80 marks.

1st - Krishiv Bansal - 99.4 percent (**State Topper**)

2nd - Rehaan Gupta - 99 percent

3rd - Gaatha Mittal, Gursifat Sekhon and Vriti Sharma - 98 percent

The warm gesture of the students was reciprocated by the teachers with the latter putting up a splendid performance dedicated to their students on the occasion of the Children's Day, November 14.

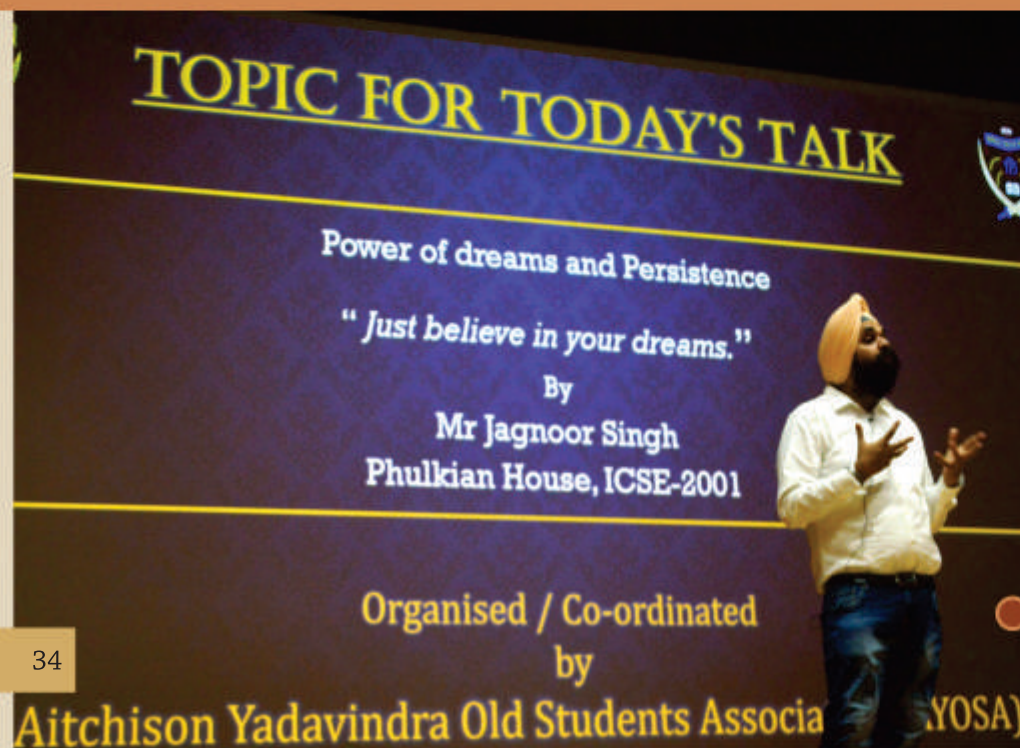

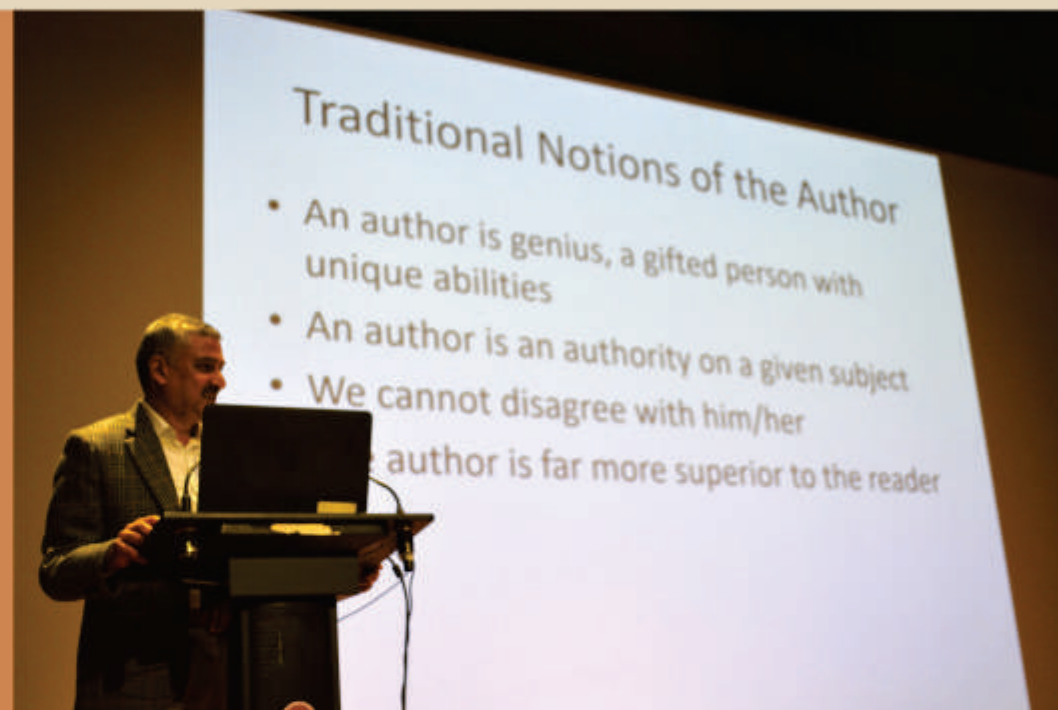


# WORDS OF WISDOM - OY TALKS
